Reading/Writing Connection

- File It! Complete the Favorite Books File handout to share with a classmate. <u>http://read.ssisd.net/read_tac_toe/docs/Favbookfile.pdf</u>
- Sell It! Suddenly the book becomes a best seller. Write a one page letter to a movie producer to persuade the producer to make your book into a movie. Explain why the characters, problems, and plot would make a good film. Only use books that have not already been made into a film.
- Buy It! or Trash It! Dear Librarian Write a one page letter to your school librarian asking to either purchase additional copies of this book or withdraw this book from the shelves. Explain your decision and use persuasion to convince the librarian to follow your suggestion.
